NEW BUSINESS

UCTC Resolution 2018-05: Amendment to the UCTC Federal Year (FFY) 2017 – 2021
Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to Add New NYSDOT PIN 893294: Route
209/Catskill Branch RR Crossing Surface Replacement. At the request of the New York
State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT), an amendment to the UCTC 2017-2021
Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is proposed in order to program a new project on the
UCTC TIP. NYSDOT PIN 893294 programs \$0.180m in Federal Highway Safety Improvement
Program Rail funds for the purposes of replacement of surface materials at the Catskill Branch
Railroad crossing on US 209 in the Town of Ulster. The project seeks to leverage timing of the
pending closure and detour for the replacement of the nearby Route 209 bridge by coordinating
project construction timelines and thereby diminishing inconvenience to the travelling public.
UCTC TIP Modification and Amendment Procedures stipulate that any new project or project

phase to be added to the TIP requires Technical Committee Approval, 15 day public comment period, and Policy Committee approval prior to adoption. In an effort to expedite the referenced project to meet critical project deadlines, UCTC initiated public comment on April 19th with a deadline of May 3rd.
