Chairman Brown called the meeting to order and Mr. Leibowitz read the roll call.

 - Ms. Pecora requested an additional month to review the possible nominations due to difficulties scheduling. They requested a vote to extend the current officers an additional month. Mr. Gidaly made the motion. Mr. Konior seconded it. Approved unanimously.

6. PLANNING DEPARTMENT REPORTS

a. Financial Report

Mr. Doyle noted the budget will be voted on December 2nd for the County so we will know what the board and department have to work in 2022 with once it is adopted. No issues finishing the year. Encumbering money for contracts to carry over to 2022. Also carrying the cost of an RFP into the new year as well. Mr. Baden asked about potential changes to the Capital Projects budget by the legislature. Mr. Doyle was not aware of any proposed changes.

- c. Communications

Lead Agency request to Village of Saugerties parking law and a Lead agency request for a lodging project. Both are on the referral agenda for this evening.

- d. Director/Staff Reports
 - Mr. Doyle informed the Board that Marianne Ananew, Administrative Assistant, would be out for 6 to 8 weeks following surgery and that any requests should go to other staff while she is out.
 - Mr. Doyle gave an update on the Midtown Linear Park and the Kingston Rail Trail
 - Mr. Doyle mentioned reviewing bid documents for the Public Safety Radio Tower in the Town of Saugerties.
 - Staff is involved in the siting process of four additional public safety towers in the County.
 - Staff is also working on siting an emergency government operations center. \$13,000,000 project. RFP is almost complete and written mostly by staff. 12 to 13,000 building is anticipated.
 - The Ulster County Transportation Council (UCTC) is working on its Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). They've begun a call for projects and anticipate they will plan between \$900,000 and \$1.2 M in transportation studies including a Route 9W Corridor Study in the Town of Ulster.
 - Applying for funding for a Farmland Agricultural Protection Plan.
 - Following up on the 2021 Ulster County Housing Action Plan with Housing/Smart Communities Program. Working with Patterns for Progress
 - Working with RUPCO on an \$800,000 housing rehab program
 - Working on designation with ARP funds in coordination with County Executive for housing-related funding.
 - Day-to-day operations of Ulster County
 - Dennis said we will be adding a staff person in 2022 to work on housing issues.
 - Dennis mentioned County Executive's office is reorganizing and our contact upstairs will change due to the departure of Evelyn Wright.

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- Ms. Welton asked about the status of the Public Safety Tower projects, particularly in Shandaken. Mr. Doyle stated that the County would be the owner and the contact for the project. May add carriers to it, but none identified yet. The Tower is needed for safety coverage and will be built with or without a carrier. Shandaken Planning Board can give feedback on sites.
- Mr. McLaughlin offered to do the minutes, but Mr. Doyle declined. Staff will handle it.
- Mr. McLaughlin asked about the traffic signal status at Route 28 and 44/55 in Gardiner. Mr. Doyle stated that the signal will be installed in 2022. Rapid flashing beacons will be installed this coming spring. The County is in process of purchasing lighted "stop ahead" signs for the Bryunswick Road portion.
- Ms. Gotto asked about the appointment of the Director under the county charter. Ms. Pecora noted there are some considerations regarding a charter change and how the Director position is appointed.
- e. Capital Improvements Program Planning Board Comments Letter
 - Dennis completed the draft and received feedback from the board regarding the County Planning Board's comments on the County's capital improvement program. Minor grammatical changes were made by Mr. Boggess to the draft letter. Mr. Doyle created a cover letter for Mr. Brown to sign that includes an offer to meet with the legislature to discuss the Board's comments. Motion: McLaughlin, Second: Wilkin. Motion carried unanimously.
