## Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617.6(b)(3)(i) of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act [SEQRA] Regulations, Ulster County is circulating herewith the annexed Revised Part 1 SEQRA Full Environmental Assessment Form (FEAF) and associated site plan for the construction of a Government Operations Center to be located at Paradies Lane in the Town of New Paltz ("the Project"). The revised FEAF form changes include: i)proposed encroachment into wetland buffer areas as defined under the Town of New Paltz Wetland Statute (project description); ii)references to important scenic resources (Scenic Resources E-3(h)); iii) the need for a 65-70 foot communication tower (project description) and iiii) a revised site plan. The Project has been classified as a Type I Action by the Ulster County Legislature on November 15. 2022 and in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617.6(a) and the Ulster County Legislature assumed lead agency upon the passage on 30 days.

The Project involves the construction of an approximately 16,000 SF government operations center with parking for approximately 65 vehicles. The Project will use an on-site septic system. On-site or municipal water supply alternatives are being explored. Access to the site will utilize the existing Paradies Lane with a proposed connection to South Ohioville Road. The Project is being designed as a net zero carbon footprint building. Rooftop solar will be used as will geothermal heating.

The County is proposing to purchase the entire 57.3 acre site consisting of Tax Map Parcels (SBL)86.12-5-12.320 & 86.12-5-310 of which approximately 6.5-7.0 acres will be reserved to house the Project.

Involved Agencies include the Town of New Paltz Town Board and Planning Board, the New York State Department of Homeland Security, New York State Department of Environmental Conservation as well as required consultation with the New York State Office of Parks and Recreation and Historic Preservation. In addition, the County will coordinate with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the US Army Corps of Engineers and the Federal Aviation Administration. The County is seeking to utilize a "Balancing of Public Interests" analytic approach as part of the local municipal land use approval process in recognition of the nature of the use proposed and County's clear governmental interest in the Project.
