 - a) <u>Draft UCTC Resolution 2021-04: Amendment to the UCTC Federal Fiscal Year 2020-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to Add New NYSDOT Project PIN 801847 as Shown in Attachment 1.</u>

At the request of the New York State Department of Transportation Region 8, UCTC Resolution 2021-04 seeks to add PIN 801847: *Route 28 Shared Use Path From Onteora Middle School to Route 28A, Town of Olive in Ulster County.* The project will utilize State Dedicated Funds and Federal National Highway Performance Program funds for a total \$0.420m in funds. The addition or removal of any project to the UCTC TIP that utilizes federal transportation aid constitutes an amendment to the TIP and therefore requires both Technical and Policy Committee approval as well as 15 day public comment period. The 15 day public review and comment period will open the week after Technical Committee approval.
